



Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy

Wantirna Club believes that individuals have the right to choose to consume alcohol in licensed venues as a form of social activity. As a Club, we have a responsibility to help minimise the risk of harm to individuals, our staff, other customers, and to the wider community.

We have a responsibility to demonstrate best practice in terms of our service of alcohol and to set a positive example to our customers and to other licensees by complying with and, where appropriate, exceeding mandatory compliance regulations.

Ethics In Practice

Wantirna Club does not promote any practice which may encourage rapid or excessive consumption of alcohol. Wantirna Club actively participates in local liquor accords, forums and appropriate industry bodies.

Wantirna Club Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy

Wantirna Club is committed to conducting all aspects of alcohol service in a professional and responsible manner, complying with all applicable laws and adhering to endorsed Liquor Service Codes of Practice.

Management and staff are aware of and adhere to all the rules and regulations applicable to responsible service of alcohol.

Wantirna Club endeavours to provide a safe and friendly environment in which all customers can socialise and enjoy themselves.

Wantirna Club does not sanction or approve of any promotions that may encourage the rapid or excessive consumption of alcohol in any of its venues. Employees are required to encourage and promote responsible consumption of alcohol.

Wantirna Club acknowledges that drunkenness, under-age drinking and alcoholism are serious social issues and therefore supports initiatives that assist in addressing and preventing these issues.

Our staff endeavour to prevent underage drinking in our venues by requiring valid proof of age from young adults to be presented in the form of an Australian driver's licence, passport or other proof of age card permitted under applicable State law.

Wantirna Club will continue to provide employee education and customer awareness programs on Responsible Service of Alcohol.
